Winterize. If you are an absentee owner, please be sure your home is kept warm enough to prevent water pipes from freezing. The resultant damage can be very expensive.

Conservation. A good start to our

winter certainly brings hope for a little relief from the dry winters of the past four years. Still, be cautious with water use. Leaky toilets can consume a great deal of water. Hot tubs are notorious for faulty fill mechanisms and leaks in the supply lines. Water softeners are often a source of lost water when they malfunction. Situations like this can amount to the loss of millions of gallons across the water system when they are not repaired.

Coming Soon! Our website is in the process of being revamped with a fresh interface. A new option for online bill pay will be introduced in the coming months.

Our Meter Upgrade project is continuing its rollout. Our updated phone system will be completed in the next few weeks. And we are also in the process of acquiring new safety equipment for our operations.
